

What to expect as Kids Return to 275



We really want Salt Kids Sunday Sessions to be a fueling point for you to keep teaching and training your kids at home. We also want your input and involvement to help your kids have the best time they can at Salt kids. Here's some info to help you relate with your kids about what happens on a Sunday.

Bring munch and sip- pack a labelled fruit snack and bottled water. If you bring in a bag, label the front of the bag too, so it's easy for leaders to find your child's items.

Sign in- we will open sign in from 9:45am so that all kids are settled at 10 ready for the livestream to commence in the gathering area. You can sign all your kids in at once at the sign in desk. Make sure you get a sticker so the leaders know you've signed in. Kids will be in session from sign in and finish at about 11:30. Please collect children age 0-5 from their room after session. School age children are brought into the back of the church building to find you.

Our leaders- Our leaders are volunteers on a 4 weekly roster. All leaders are safe ministry trained and have a current Working with Children Check. Prepare your kids to meet new leaders.

Our program- Each session runs on a simple routine with play, snack and bible time. Kids will have the opportunity to do whole group activities and some free play choices. Please talk with your child about how they can join in and love others as they participate. Encourage them to follow the leader to participate as asked.

Loving others at Salt kids- We have some simple behaviour expectations to help kids love each other and learn at Salt kids sunday sessions. The three basic expectations are to Listen, Be Kind and Join in. Have a chat with your kids about how they can do that at Salt kids. Occasionally, we might ask your child to take a break and sit with you to help them think about how to keep loving the group with these expectations. The kids are welcome to rejoin the group when you/they feel they are ready. The leader will chat with you after the gathering to explain what happened and answer any questions.
